



Here is a brief update on our re-opening plan.

Later this week, Catholic school principals will receive re-opening guidelines from the Catholic Schools Office of the Archdiocese of Washington.

The SJB Recovery and Reopening Team will meet on Monday night, July 20, to make recommendations based on the guidelines of the Catholic Schools Office.

A communication with updated information about the SJB re-opening plan will be sent to all school families on Wednesday, July 22.

We realize there are many questions about how SJB will re-open for the 2020-21 school year. Some have asked if the school will follow the phase-in reopening plan just released by Montgomery County Public Schools. Catholic schools leaders have said that Catholic schools may not be bound to the same model that county schools must follow.

We will know more over the next week, and we will share the updated information we learn with you on July 22. Until then, we thank you for your continued patience, your understanding, and your support for SJB.

Three Dates Ahead

- **Wednesday to Friday, July 15-17 -- The Catholic Schools Recovery Task Force will roll out elements of the re-opening guidelines for Archdiocesan schools.**
- **Monday, July 20, at 6 pm -- The St. John the Baptist Recovery and Reopening Committee will meet to make reopening recommendations.**
- **Wednesday, July 22 -- A school-wide email will go to SJB families with updated information about the re-opening plan.**
