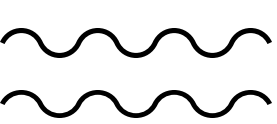

Please email your homeroom teacher if your student will not be online or in class that day



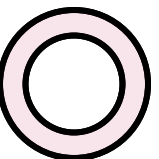

- Students in Study Skills will have a different link to access instruction on Tue-Thurs

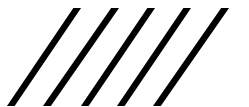


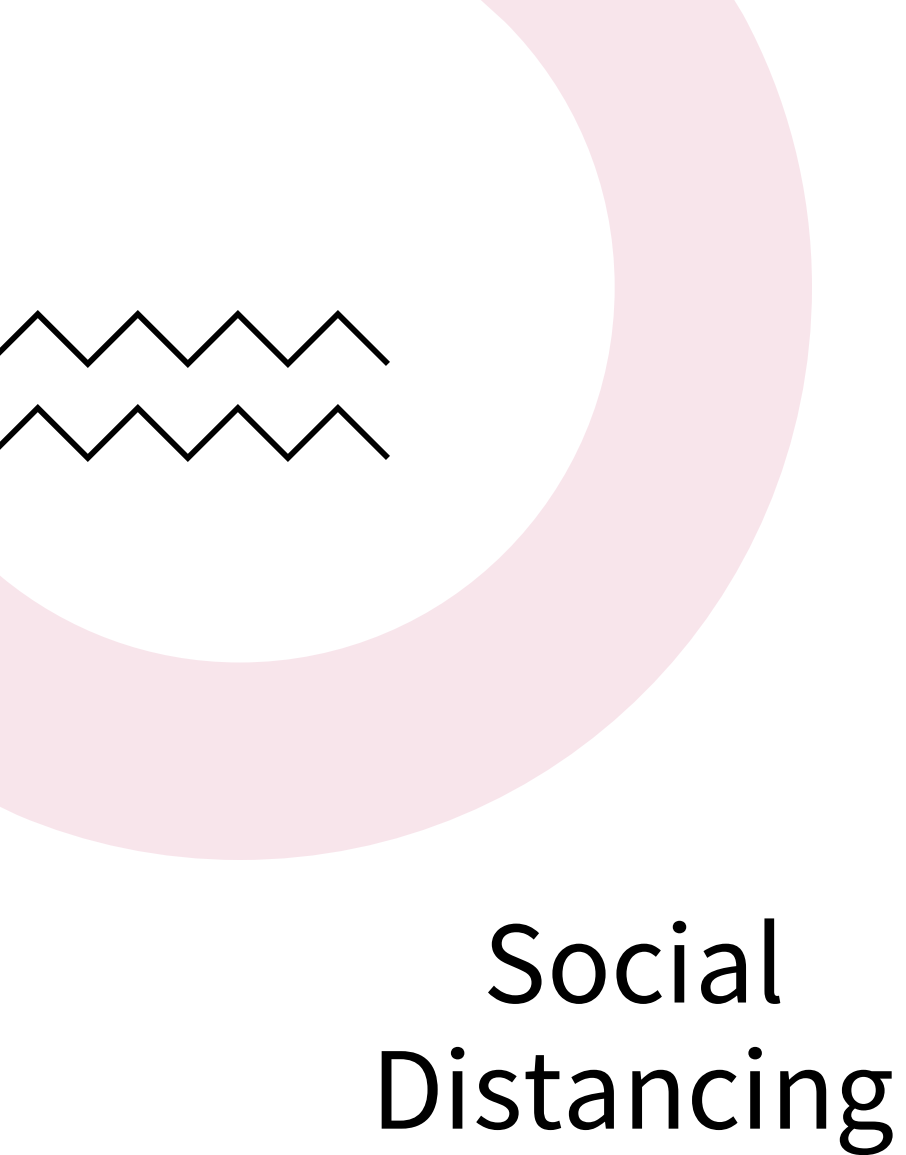


Face Coverings



- Masks for In Person Learners
 - Worn every day in the classroom
 - Worn at recess
 - Worn at PE
 - Not worn at lunch
 - May be removed outside if students are in a stationary spot
 - Students should bring two masks to school on PE day
 - Please wash masks regularly
 - Teachers will abide by these same protocols

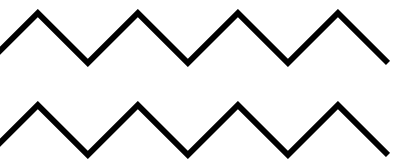




Social Distancing

- Students must maintain 6' distance from one another as much as possible at all times
 - Walking to PE
 - Walking to break/recess times
 - Walking to smaller Math/Study Skills spaces





Reducing Risk



- Keeping clean and safe requires cooperation. All classrooms will have disinfectant and cleaning supplies
- IPLs should bring these from home and keep at the desk:
 - Hand Sanitizer
 - Tissues
 - Wipes (if you can find them)
 - Water bottle



○ Behavior

- Misconduct in the upper grades regarding masks, distancing, or sharing of sanitation products will not be allowed
 - All rules and procedures will be explained and demonstrated in the first week of school
 - Redirecting behavior will be first step by teachers who observe safety infractions
 - Repeated behavior problems will result in student being sent to isolation area and parents called
 - Continued behavior infractions will result in student becoming a Distance Learner

Distance Learners

- Awake, appropriate dress, and online by 8 am
- Cameras should be on
- Respectful during prayer
- Attentive to classroom; no side gaming or chats
- Able to raise hand and ask questions
- Participate when possible

In Person Learners

- Arrive after 7:45 am for screening before entering classroom
- In correct uniform
- Respectful during prayer
- Attentive to classroom
- Abide by safety procedures
- Participate when possible





Devices

- All Middle School students must have a compatible device for Microsoft Teams (Chrome browser installed)
- IPLs will bring their devices to school each day fully charged and take it home each afternoon to charge overnight
- DLs must be online with their devices during the regular school day hours except for breaks and lunch (although they can stay connected during that time)

For IPLs, please label anything coming to school: uniforms, jackets, devices, folders, water bottles, etc



For IPLs, cell phones should remain turned off and in the backpack during the school day



For DLs, links will be shown in the Microsoft Teams calendar: no emails each week, simply log in to Teams and access your child's calendar to access the classroom livestream


