In order for this to happen, we are in need of 1-2 people to chair each of our different events.

Vacancies for 2022-2023 school year:

Buddy Family (1 Chair)

Welcoming new families during the summer is a popular custom at St. John the Baptist. Prior to the beginning of the school year, members of the community contact new families, not only to extend a welcome, but also to provide information and assistance.

*Chairs pair up the current and new families and provide guidance for current families to assist our incoming families.

Family Flix (1-2 Chairs)

Family Flix is a tradition held in the fall on a Friday evening. A large movie screen is setup on the field and families bring blankets and lawn chairs.

*Chairs select movies for students to vote on and provide flyers to promote ticket sales for the event. They request volunteers to help set-up and run the check in table for the event.

Breakfast with Santa (1-2 Chairs)

BWS is an annual event held the first Saturday morning in December. Parent volunteers decorate and transform SJB into a Christmas Wonderland. Santa is available for photos with children and families. The 7th and 8th grade students star in the character parade, and the 6th grade elves help as needed. Breakfast is provided.

*Chairs promote ticket sales with flyers, purchase food, decorations and work with 7th and 8th grade room parents to gather volunteers for the character parade. Chairs organize volunteers to prepare food and staff the event.

What is the HSA?

HSA stands for Home School Association, a partnership organization of school and families. Some schools have a PTA, a Parent-Teacher Association. The HSA is like a PTA.



Father/Daughter Dance (1-2 Chairs)

The dance takes place on a Saturday in February. It is a chance for the girls to show off their best outfit and hit the dance floor with their friends (and their dads).

*Chairs promote ticket sales with flyers, organize volunteers and decorate for the event. They will hire a DJ, photo booth or photographer and plan for snacks and activities during the dance.

Annual Gala (1-2 Chairs)

The Gala takes place on the last night of the Spring Auction. Combined with the auction, it is the school's main fundraiser, which helps the school raise money for educational materials, technology, facility improvements, and tuition assistance.

*Chairs plan the theme and decide on the venue for the event. The chairs will organize volunteers to decorate and set up. They will promote through flyers, social media and the school website. The chairs will collaborate with the auction chairs to have auction items setup for viewing during the gala.

Room Parent Coordinator (1 chair)

The Room Parent Coordinator is the room parent liaison to the HSA. The RPC disseminates information to the room parents to share with their classes. RPC works with the room parents to set up the schedule for Teacher Appreciation Week and class participation in community events (i.e. cookies after the Christmas Show).

HSA Chair

The HSA chair works with the SJB School Board and Principal to coordinate all HSA Community Building and Fundraising events. The HSA chair is the contact for the event chairs and the Room Parent Coordinator.
