

If a temperature reading is 100.4 or higher...

- the screener informs the parent of the temperature reading
- the screener advises the parent that it's a high reading
- the screener advises the parent that a second reading will be taken
- the first screener asks a second screener to take a reading with a separate device

If a second temperature reading is 100.4 or higher...

- the first screener informs the parent of the second temperature reading
- the first screener advises the parent that the second temperature is high
- the first screener advises the parent that the child must stay home until the child is fever free for 24 hours
- the first screener advises the parent that siblings also must stay home
- the screener advises the parent to watch for symptoms of covid-19 or other illness
- the screener advises the parent that the sibling may return the following school day if there are no symptoms in the home

If a second temperature reading is less than 100.4...

- the first screener informs the parent of the second temperature reading
- the first screener informs the parent that a third reading will be taken
- the first screener asks the third screener to take a temperature reading with separate device

If the third temperature reading is less than 100.4...

- the first screener informs the parent of the third temperature reading
- the first screener informs the parent that the child may come to school
- the first screener informs the parent that the child's temperature will be recorded again during the school day

If the third temperature reading is 100.4 or higher...

- the first screener informs the parent of the third temperature reading
- the first screener advises the parent that the third temperature reading is high
- the first screener advises the parent that the child must stay home until the child is fever free for 24 hours
- the first screener advises the parent that siblings also must stay home
- the screener advises the parent to watch for symptoms of covid-19 or other illness
- the screener advises the parent that the sibling may return to school the following school day if there are no symptoms in the home

If a student's first temperature reading is lower than 100.4, the student may come to school. If it's higher than 99.5 but less than 100.4, inform the classroom teacher, who should monitor the student. An additional temperature reading should be taken between 9:30 am and 11:30 am.
